Capstone Plagiarism Statement

Plagiarism is the intentional passing off or the attempt to pass off another's work as one's own. Plagiarism is also the unintentional failure to give sufficient credit to one's sources.

The Graduate catalog states:

Students are expected to pursue their studies adhering to the basic principles of academic honesty. Students who are guilty of plagiarism or academic dishonesty in their studies and their research will not be permitted to continue in the Graduate Program.
